I had the privilege of being part of the inaugural SeaWorld Run for the Fund in 2010 and would recommend this upcoming event to anyone (Oct 1, 2011). Participants varied from those of all abilities and ages, young and beyond :-). The time of year the event takes place is perfect for a 10K and just plain fun for those wanting to run the 5K. The entry fee includes the run, free parking and access to SeaWorld for the remainder of the day. Just after the run, a light snack breakfast awaited and it was delightful with honeycrisp apples and huge homemade-like sugar cookies, water, juice.
